## 1. Accessories

Products: Lucky Clover, Triangle, Capt'n hook, c+c, Babel, Mozartkugel, Colourcouple, Personality Socks, Luci



**Lucky Clover - umbrella stand** Your 'good luck charm' umbrella stand. Big umbrellas can be stored within the four leaves of the endless plastic strings. Small pocket umbrellas can be hooked up on the top of the stand. Designed by roomsafari.

**Triangle - cloth hanger** A musical companion for clothes, inspired by a traditional music instrument. Designed by roomsafari.

**capt'n hook - blackboard or mirror** A mobile assistant either in the version of a blackboard for notes or in the version of a mirror. Easy to hang – wherever you need it.

**c+c - hooks** Single or couple or chain – one hook and a lot of possibilities. Designed by roomsafari



**Babel - card storage** Babel restores order when the chaos in paperwork reaches biblical proportions. Everything that is destined to vanish from the desk, business cards, tickets, invitations, certificates, receipts can be safely secured on one of the five stories in the Tower of Babel, thanks to the cleverly shaped slots. Babel will turn any mess into a gorgeous geometrical arrangement. Crafted on the edge of the Black Forest using local woods. Designed by Adam & Harborth



**Mozartkugel - music box** A turn of the elegantly shaped key magically produces one of Mozart's melodies from inside the solid wooden ball. The 18-note chime plays whether the ball is rolling across the floor or standing on a table as an intriguing ornament. Manufactured in a village on the edge of the Black Forest, the chime is mounted in premium quality wood that has been fashioned into a perfect sphere. Though the mechanism remains hidden, the music will always escape the bounds of the geometric form. Designed by Adam & Harborth



**Colourcouple - matching game** Who can find the most pairs of colours? Many schoolbooks even claim that it is almost impossible. colourcouple proves that assumption to be wrong. The amusing and educational matching game includes 60 cards with 30 different objects. Also available in different versions: doubleboom (flowers), sweetsweets (sweets) or roundabout (everyday objects). Designed by Adam & Harborth



**Personality Socks - floor protection** An amusing protection for your floor and a play with associations. The cheerfully patterned socks give personality to your chair while saving your floor from typical scratch marks. The socks fit perfectly on legs with a perimeter of 9 - 13,5 cm. Available in sets of four equal socks. Designed by Chris & Ruby



**Luci - cocoon** Luci is best defined as an up-to-date hanging basket. Four metal rings are knotted into a macramé net, turning the structure into a cocoon. A common flowerpot is placed into the lower ring. The draining hole is plugged with a cork, offering the possibility to drain superfluous water when needed. The big macramé loops offer the plant enough room to grow beyond the restrictions of its cocoon. Designed by Ilot Ilov

## 2. Furniture

Products: Loll, James, leanon II, Youtoo



**Loll - side table** Loll explores the possibilities of stretching to transform simple metal sheets in to three-dimensional furniture solutions. Stretching the laser cut steel sheet up to maximum strain creates a static equilibrium. With this simple but ingenious technique, a metal sheet just 3 mm thick has been turned into a coffee table. Designed by e27



**James - tripod** is a true servant with the ability to be set up in any given place. The small, three-legged table is connected through a riveted joint. There is no need for a tabletop as a single plate is turned into an individual tray within the twinkling of an eye. Plate, bowl or vase are transformed into objects hovering in space. The wooden sticks keep everything in balance while the rubber-tipped tips diminish the danger of sliding crockery. After use, the effective butler is stored without effort, folding easily back into a handy format. Designed by Ilot Ilov



**leanon II - wardrobe** The new generation of the approved mobile coatrack can be leaned against every wall. It comes in a small box and is easy to built up. There are hidden magnets on both ends to fetch keys. Designed by roomsafari.

**YOUTOO - wardrobe** The wardrobe Youtoo is inspired by the interiors of changing and locker rooms you can find in schools, squash centers or at swimming pools. Youtoo simplifies the design of these traditional and massive constructions offering a minimal, light and functional design that makes it a treat to change wherever you like to place it. ### 3. Tableware

Products: Transfer, Nusskubus, Stillleben, Railway, Bruce



**Transfer - cutting board** Transfer allows you to insert a plate, so that you can just slide your freshly cut ingredients on the plate. This way your cutting board stays nice and clean for the next ingredient to be prepared. Fits any plate up to a diameter of 23 cm and 3 cm height. LOLL side table Loll explores the possibilities of stretching to transform simple metal sheets in to three-dimensional furniture solutions. **Nusskubus - nutcracker** brings the archaic cracking of nuts right into the living room of highly civilized persons. Not far removed from the first blow of a hand-axe, the fully clothed homo sapiens now sits at the table and cracks nuts with two hardwood cubes. The procedure is made easier by three different anvil-hollows suitable for common sizes of nuts. What remains of the primitive hand-axe: the deliberate blow, the immediate success and the accompanying pleasure. Designed by Adam & Harborth



**Stillleben - fruit bowl** An elegant bowl, solid and dynamic at the same time featuring two graceful squirrels loyally guarding stored fruits and nuts. The sculptural creation of a picture-perfect still life (German: Stillleben). Concealed in the profile of each precious oak ring the squirrels only reveal the secret of their origin in the silhouettes at the cut ends mirroring their elusive natural behaviour. 'Reifendrehen' is the name for this exceptional German craft where solid oak wood is manually turned into a ring with a predefined outline creating the desired shape. Traditionally this craft was developed to manufacture little wooden figurines. Stillleben captures the spirit of this tradition and offers a modern interpretation of the craft where the small opening in the ring forms an integral part of the sculpturally shaped bowl. A separate third squirrel is presented to give a playful ease, poised to take a nut or two. Designed by Adam & Harborth



**Railway - fruit bowl** Fruits and vegetables no longer go off the rails. Some like it warm and airy: especially fruits like avocados, tomatoes or bananas. Designed by roomsafari



**Bruce - trivet** A puristic and variable trivet for small and huge pots with a simple and archaic construction - just made of one silicon string and two wooden sticks. The trivet is easy to hang up in the kitchen. Designed by roomsafari

#### 4. Lighting

Products: Pluma Cubic, Ray, Matt, T-light



**Pluma cubic - feather lights** Pluma cubic is a symbiosis of natural feathers and clear, geometric forms combined to create illuminated objects. Completely hand-crafted, the lamps include up to 4000 individually selected goose or rooster feathers. The light objects illustrate the feathers' two opposing sides: one shows the spikey aspect of the quills, the other one their soft, fluffy, natural flowing beauty. Designed by Heike Buchfelder



**Ray - pendant light** Ray is a knitted lighting element, which has the capability to follow its owner on his/her heel. The cable of the pendant light is prolonged by 12 metres, thus enabling Ray to become a lying, hanging or atmospheric lamp. The possibilities for using the device are unlimited, adapting to any method of playful arrangement. The fluffy woven fabric of the knitting hides the sober technology within (like cables, socket and shade). The energy-saving bulb used for Ray radiates a warm, glowing light. Designed by Ilot Ilov



**Matt - pendant light** Matt is a knitted lighting element with the ability to dynamically adapt itself according to the individual needs of its user, changing its appearance with the place of installation. Hung as a single piece, knotted in a group or set on a hook on the wall: Matt simply fits into the scene of its placement, flexibly draping itself to the shape and situation of a room. The fluffy woven fabric of the knitting hides the sober technology within (like cables and socket) and evokes the impression of ropes meeting and melting into each other. The energy-saving bulb used for Matt radiates a warm, glowing light. Designed by Ilot Ilov



**T-light - floor light** A pure elegant led-lamp. The lamp can be leaned against the wall or in the corner creating a warm lighting atmosphere. Designed by roomsafari. Design award: form 2009
